

To mourn the unfortunate demise of our two beloved students/daughters, Aasiya Akhter (Semester VI) and Mymoona Ali (Semester VI), who passed away in the tragic accident at Vudhpora, Kupwara on 12th April, 2025 early morning when the College was on its way to oneday picnic to Tulip Garden, the College convened a Condolence Meeting in one of its lawns from 11:25 am to 11:55 am on 15th April, 2025.

Heartfelt condolences were extended to the beavered families of the deceased in particular and to the College Fraternity in general. The passing away of the two budding students was declared to be a great loss to the whole Lolab Valley. The College Fraternity vowed that the moral integrity and ethical uprightness of these students would never be lost sight of.









A prayer session was also held in the meeting for the peace of the departed souls and the speedy recovery of the students and staff who were injured in the fatal accident.
